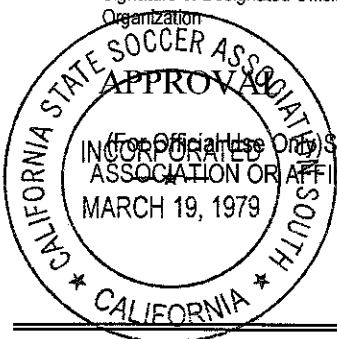

## ORANGE COUNTY SOCCER REFEREE ASSOCIATION TOURNAMENT AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into between the Orange County Soccer Referee Association (OCSRA), and Bayern Cup

- (1) OCSRA will provide soccer referees for Bayern Cup Tournament to be held August 28,29, 2010
- (2) An advance payment of 90% of estimated fees is to be submitted 10 day prior to the start of the tournament. Date to be submitted: August 18, 2010 in the amount of \$ TBA. The advance payment is refundable minus incurred costs if the tournament is canceled due to inclement weather or natural disaster.
- (3) Parking fees incurred by game officials or referee administrators shall be reimbursed by the tournament. Details of these fees will be included on the final bill.
- (4) On site Referee Administrators, if requested by you, shall be paid \$15.00 per hour.
  - a.   0   Number needed. To be assigned by the OCSRA assignor.
  - b.   12   Maximum hours each on site referee administrator is to be paid.
- (5) Total Game Fees will be based on \$1.30 per playing minute or the current rates used in CYSA-S National Cup or the current CSL season, whichever is greater.
  - a. 3 Referees: 100% of total game fee.
  - b. 2 Referees: 80% of total game fee. 1 referee, 1 AR and 1 Club AR. The Club AR is not paid
  - c. 1 Referee: 60% of total game fee. 2 Club ARs. The Club ARs are not paid
  - d. U9 or U10 games on short sided field with just one game official assigned: \$40.00 per game.
  - e. Assignor Fees: \$5.50 for multi-official games and \$3.50 for single-official (U9 and U10) games assigned.
  - f. All changes made to the schedule less then 48 hours to the Tournament will have a Assignor Fee of \$10.00 per game

NOTE: Adjustments for missing assigned referees will be made on the final billing statement.

- (6) Games will be officiated according to FIFA Laws Of The Game using the diagonal system of control, CYSA-So and your rules of competition. Referees will complete game reports on forms provided by the tournament and additional reports, if required.
- (7) Game schedules are to be submitted latest 10 days prior to start of the competition. A surcharge of \$100.00 per day will be applied for every day over the ten day submission requirement. Game schedules shall include:
  - a. Field Location
  - b. Start Time
  - c. Age Group i.e. U10, U19 & Gender of teams

For games canceled less than 48 hours prior to start of the tournament, the full game fee shall be paid. Games canceled prior to the 48 hour limit may be subject of assignor fees. OCSRA will charge a flat Sub-contracting fee of \$300.00 on which we are the prime contractor for cost of securing outside association coverage.

# US Youth Soccer

## TOURNAMENT OR GAMES HOSTING AGREEMENT

In consideration of permission being granted to South Coast Bayern to hold a tournament or games at South Coast Bayern Huntington Beach Calif  
(Hosting Organization) (City) (State)

On the dates of August 28 and 29, 2010, we agree to the following conditions:

**ABIDE BY RULES:** We shall abide by all statements made in our approved US Youth Soccer *Application to Host A Tournament or Games*, in our tournament invitation, in our tournament rules, in the US Youth Soccer *Travel and Tournament Policy* and in this US Youth Soccer *Tournament or Games Hosting Agreement*. We agree that all decisions regarding acceptance of teams into a tournament shall be fairly and impartially made and shall not be based upon race, creed, color or national origin and that we will not advertise by any means the tournament or games until all approvals are received.

**INVITATIONS:** The tournament or games approval form shall accompany all tournament or games invitations distributed.

**HOUSING:** We agree that we will not require a team to use only accommodations approved or provided by the hosting organization or other organization, unless disclosure is made on the tournament application form of the required hotel/motel names and the guaranteed rates.

**PROCURING LIABILITY INSURANCE:** We have procured liability insurance coverage for the tournament or games with limits of not less than \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000 which names the State Association or Affiliate with which the Hosting Organization is a member. A copy of the certificate of insurance, IF REQUIRED, is attached issued by \_\_\_\_\_

**REQUIRING MEDICAL AUTHORIZATIONS:** We shall require all teams participating in the tournament or games to provide medical releases for each player in an appropriate form. These authorizations shall be reviewed by the Hosting Organization at registration and kept in the possession of a team official

**ADVANCE PUBLICATION OF RULES:** We agree that our tournament or games rules shall be included with the invitation sent to each team and shall, again, be published to all teams accepted prior to the start of the tournament/games.

**CREDENTIALS CHECKS:** We agree that we shall conduct credentials checks to ensure that all players are registered with US Youth Soccer or US Soccer or a member thereof or their national association, properly rostered with their team, and participating in accordance with representations set forth on the US Youth Soccer *Application to Host a Tournament or Games*. We agree that we will not modify or mark in any way original rosters or member passes; and will not register any player, coach, or team official or issue any member pass.

**USE OF US SOCCER REGISTERED REFEREES:** We agree that we shall use for all games only US Soccer registered referees who are in good standing (unless US Soccer has granted a waiver to allow the use of authorized referees from another country), and shall use a one- or 3-referee system. We intend to use a 3-referee system for the following age groups: U9 thru U14 Boys and Girls. There will be an adequate number of US Soccer registered referees available in the area during the tournament or game dates to cover the scheduled games. **AVAILABILITY OF POLICE AND RESCUE SERVICE:** We have notified the local police, ambulance, and emergency rescue services of the date of the tournament or games and the times and fields which will be used for games, and have been advised by them that they will be available to render assistance if needed. 
**TOURNAMENT OR GAME RULES – BEHAVIOR:** We agree that our tournament or game rules contain provisions ensuring that the behavior of teams, players, coaches, and spectators is appropriately controlled, including specific provisions that—


- Spell out the disciplinary measures to be imposed for the issuance of red and yellow cards or other improper conduct;
- indicate what procedures will be followed regarding protests and appeals;
- indicate that all disciplinary measures imposed by hosting organizations shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual's group participation in the tournament/games;
- record the issuance of all red and yellow cards and other matters involving the conduct of a team, its players, coaches, and supporters and also report them immediately to the home State Association and the home club/league of the team; and
- state that the home State Association or member thereof and the home club or league shall, except in the case of referee assault or abuse, have the responsibility for imposing, should circumstances warrant, additional penalties within their respective jurisdictions with regard to any matters arising from the tournament or games.

**TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION:** We agree that our tournament or game rules shall state what refunds, if any, shall be made to participating teams if all or a portion of the tournament or games is cancelled by the hosting organization for any reason.

**POST TOURNAMENT OR GAMES REPORT:** We agree that we shall file any required Post Tournament or Games Report with the State Association or Affiliate granting us permission to host this tournament or games within 30 days after the conclusion of the tournament or games. We understand that failure to file the report may preclude the tournament/games host from receiving approval for any tournament/games for the following seasonal years until the report is filed. The Post Tournament or Games Report shall include the following information:

- the number of teams participating in each age group (boys and girls);
- if a champion is determined, the name of the champion for each group;
- the number of teams from each State Association, Affiliate, other Organization Member, or foreign country;
- if "Sportsmanship Awards" are given, the criteria for the award and to whom awards were given;
- the number of fields used for the tournament/games;
- the name of the sponsor, if any; and
- the names and teams of all players issued red and yellow cards, and details of any other matters involving the improper or unsporting conduct of a team, its players, coaches or supporters. **NOTE: Any incident of referee assault or referee abuse by a player, coach, manager, club official, or game official must be reported to the alleged offender's home State Association, or member thereof immediately, but in no event later than 48 hours after an incident of referee assault or abuse..**

# **BAYERN JR. CUP 2010 RULES**

## **Rules and Regulations**

This tournament shall be played under F.I.F.A. rules, as modified by the Bayern Jr. Cup Committee, for youth competition. All games will adhere to the rules set forth with the following additions/clarifications:

- Decisions relating to the interpretation of the Tournament Rules can only be made by the Tournament Director. Tournament Director may delegate authority to Site Manager or Field Marshall if the Tournament Director is not present at game site.
- Disputes relating to the interpretation of these rules will be resolved with the administrators/coaches that are registered with the involved team(s). Individuals may not represent a team if not registered as an administrator/coach with the involved team(s).
- All decisions, judgments, and calls of tournament referees and Tournament Director or designated Field Marshall are final. No protests will be allowed.

## **Eligibility**

Teams will play in age brackets for 2010-2011 season but may use 2009-2010 or 2010-2011 player passes and medical releases.

U8 & U9 & U10 ages will play 8v8 with no exceptions.

Teams must be affiliated with FIFA and/or USSF and players and coaches must have laminated cards.

Unlimited loan players will be permitted with a maximum roster size of U8, U9 & U10 (14 players) and U11-U14 (18 players).

## **Registration**

Teams will register at the field of their 1<sup>st</sup> game one hour before the game's scheduled kickoff time.

There will be no additions to the team roster after the team checks in. Player cards or medical releases may be accepted later by Field Marshall but only if player is listed on the official team roster at time of the team's first check-in. At registration, a complete and signed Team Roster must be submitted by Coach

or Manager who must certify that all players are FIFA and/or USSF 2009/2010 or 2010/2011 registered players.

Laminated player cards with photo and the player's signature (for States or Countries that require signatures, photos and/or laminated cards for identification) and medical release forms will be required at registration.

### **Check-IN--Game**

With the exception of the team's 1<sup>st</sup> check-in, all teams will check-in 30 minutes prior to game time at game site. Referees will collect the player passes prior to the game and will return them to the team manager. It is the responsibility of the team manager to make sure the player passes are returned. The Coach or Team Administrator will hold Medical Release forms. The Field Marshall will collect the match cards, which must be signed by Coach or Team Administrator.

### **Conduct**

The following rules of conduct apply:

- All coaches have complete responsibility for the conduct of their players, bench, friends, and spectators at all times.
- If, in the opinion of game officials, a game must be terminated for misconduct of players, bench or spectators, the offending team can be suspended from further play and forfeit that game and all remaining games. In this event, all previous points earned remain as played.
- Any player or coach ordered from the field of play (RED CARD) will not be allowed to participate in the next match as a minimum and if violent conduct occurs the player or coach may be ejected for remainder of tournament at discretion of Tournament Director. Two YELLOW cards during match shall be ejected for remainder of the match and may serve a one game suspension at the discretion of the Tournament Director. A **one point deduction** will be given to the offending team for each **red card (double yellow included)**.
- Disciplinary measures imposed by this tournament organization for inappropriate behavior shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual player, coach, and spectator or team's participation in the tournament. Such disciplinary action will be as determined by and at the discretion of the Tournament Director or designated Field Marshall and can include exclusion from further tournament participation
- Any cards issued will be reported to US Club and USYS in a tournament report

and thereby to the home club/league of the player, coach, team or supporters involved except that all matters involving a referee assault shall, in accordance with USSF Rule II08, be referred immediately to USYS and US Club Soccer. The home state association and the home club/league of the player, coach, team or supporters shall, except in the case of referee assault, have the responsibility for imposing, should the circumstances warrant, additional sanctions within their respective jurisdictions with regard to matters arising from the tournament.

- All players are required to use shin guards at all times. No shin guards - No play!

- No casts of any kind will be allowed.

- No player may compete in the Tournament on more than one team.

## Competition Format

Home teams are listed first and will choose sides in case of a conflict. The home team will change jerseys in case of a color conflict.

All games will begin on time. A forfeit will be declared if a team cannot field a minimum of six (6) players at start time for U8, U9 and U10 and seven (7) players for U11 thru U14.

Preliminary round game times may be varied by Field Marshall to maintain game start schedules. These games may end in a tie. All preliminary games will be held on Saturday or Sunday.

Teams will be grouped into divisions according to age and gender and will play all their games within their assigned divisions.

- Teams/players will compete based on 2010/2011 age groups.

- All teams will be scheduled to play a minimum of 3 games unless the scheduled games are shortened or canceled due to rain, unforeseen circumstances such as critical injury or acts of God

- The Tournament reserves the right to alter the game formats to enhance competition and to improve the overall quality of the Tournament.

winners will play for the championship.

Quarterfinal and semifinal games (if any) ending in a tie, after regulation time, will go immediately to F.I.F.A. kicks from the penalty mark to determine the winner (special goal at site may be used for PKs). All **games with the exception of Finals** will consist of the following periods with a five (5) minute half time:

Age Brackets	Each Half
U14	30 minutes
U11 - U13	25 minutes
U8 , U9 & U10	25 minutes

All **championship games** will consist of the following periods with a ten (10) minute half time:

Age Brackets	Each Half
U14	35 minutes
U11 - U13	30 minutes
U8 – U10	25 minutes

**Championship games** ending in a tie, after regulation time, will have two five (5) minute overtime periods with Golden Goal victory (the first team to score, in overtime, wins the match). If still tied, teams will go to F.I.F.A. kicks from the penalty mark to determine the winner (special goal at site may be used for PKs).

In case of inclement weather or field conditions, games may:

- Be shortened
- Go to F.I.F.A. kicks from the penalty mark to determine the winner
- Be canceled

Games for U8-U12 will use an official size #4 ball. Games involving U13 - U14 will be played with an official size #5 ball.

## STANDINGS

The following point system will be used to determine 1st in each group and the wildcard selection during preliminary rounds:

Six (6) points for each win

Three (3) points for each tie

One (1) point for each defensive shut out (to include 0-0 ties).

Zero (0) points for each loss

1 One point for each goal scored up to a maximum of 3 goals

A forfeit is a 1-0 win

One (-1) point deduction for each ejection (red card or double yellow on a coach or a player).

At the end of each game, the **Coach or Team Administrator must carefully review and sign the score card.** Coach or Team Administrator should review

the BAYERN JR CUP website to verify scores properly recorded and contact Field Marshal and/or Tournament Director immediately of any possible errors. The score card is official match record and may not be changed except under the following circumstances:

### **Score corrections:**

If Coaches/Team Administrators of both teams, meet with Field Marshal and agree to a score correction, the Field Marshal will correct the score and other records accordingly.

If Referee verifies incorrect score was recorded, Field Marshal (with Tournaments Director's approval) may correct score and other records accordingly.

Scores incorrectly posted on Website shall be investigated by Field Marshall by checking original match record and corrected accordingly.

### **Red Card corrections:**

If Referee verifies incorrect player was recorded as receiving Red Card (includes double Yellow), Field Marshal (with Tournament Director's approval) may correct records accordingly.

### **TIE BREAKERS and WILDCARDS**

In the event of a tie on point totals for Wildcard (or within any Bracket), the following tie breaking system will apply.

- Head to Head (where applicable).
- Goal Differential, total all goals counting for (maximum 4 in any individual game) minus total all goals counting against (maximum 4 in any individual game)
- Goals Scored, total goals counting for (maximum 4 in any individual game)
- Goals Allowed, total goals counting against (maximum 4 in any individual game)
- F.I.F.A. kicks from the penalty mark will be (unless otherwise mutually agreed by both Coaches or Team Administrators) scheduled 30 minutes prior to next match at match site—special goal may be used)

## **SUBSTITUTION**

Substitution shall be allowed at the following times:

Pursuant to current FIFA Rules.

## **Special Rules**

In the event of an unusual event that results in a significant loss of game time, the lost game time may be rescheduled at the discretion of the Tournament Co-Directors. The rescheduling of the lost game time is subject to field availability. An example of an unusual event would be a major injury to a player, which prevented the use of the playing field. The Tournament defines a significant loss of game time as more than half of the game. An accumulation of time delays due to minor/moderate injuries to several players would not constitute an unusual event nor will these delays be considered lost game time. An accumulation of time delays resulting from the normal course of a game will not be considered lost game time.

Tournament Directory/Site Manager may shorten games as necessary to make sure all matches scheduled on a given field are played. For example, a field running behind schedule due to an injury may have all remaining games shortened by few minutes each game so that each game gets played.

Tournament Director or referee may suspend any match or tournament in consideration of safety to players or damage to fields in event of inclement whether under any circumstances.

Partial refunds for cancelled or suspended games will be considered by the Tournament Committee to determine the extent of a refund but said refund will not exceed \$100 per game. No refund will be allowed due to forfeit of any game by any team accepted to tournament.

Any team that withdraws from the Tournament after the team has been accepted or on or after August 15, 2010, will not receive a refund of any kind. Application to the BAYERN JR. CUP 2010 does not mean automatic acceptance into the BAYERN JR. CUP 2010. Each team accepted will be sent an email notifying the team of its' acceptance into the BAYERN JR. CUP.
